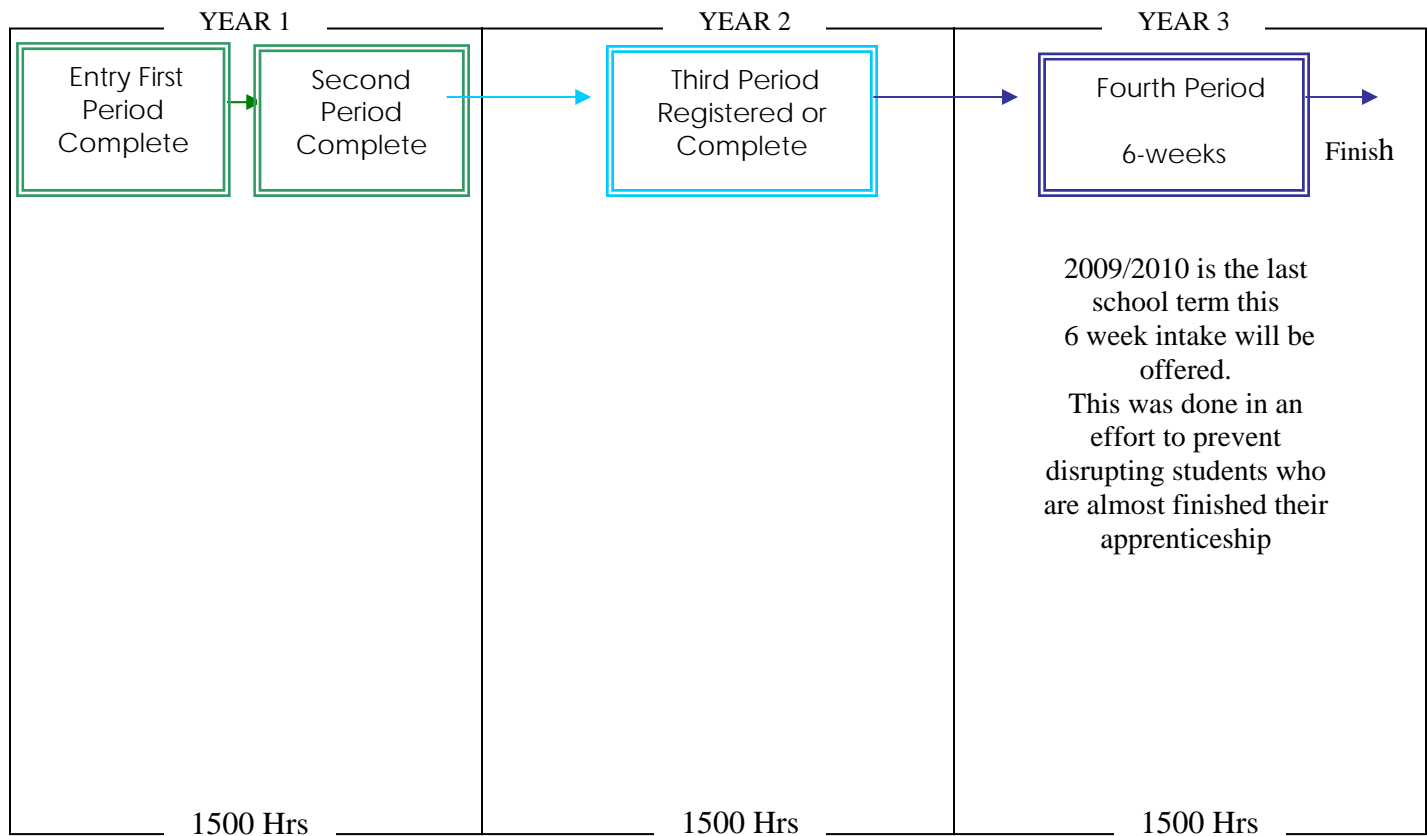




Boilermaker Apprenticeship Transition – Apprentices who have registered or received Third Period credit



Impact on your Apprenticeship

Since you have registered or have successfully completed your Third period of technical training Alberta Apprenticeship has decided to offer one last year of Fourth period technical training, so there are no disruptions to your apprenticeship. You will be eligible to register for the Fourth and final period of technical training in the 2009/2010 school term.

If you are an apprentice currently registered for Third period in the 2008/2009 school term it is to your advantage to continue and complete the Third period technical training. If you attempt to shorten your schooling by withdrawing from Third period and attempting the NEW Second Level challenge and you are unsuccessful, you will be directed to the NEW Second Level technical training and will be required to complete a total of 16 weeks of training to receive your Journeyman certification. The Boilermaker Apprenticeship Agency will not excuse withdrawals from the May 11, 2009 intake.
