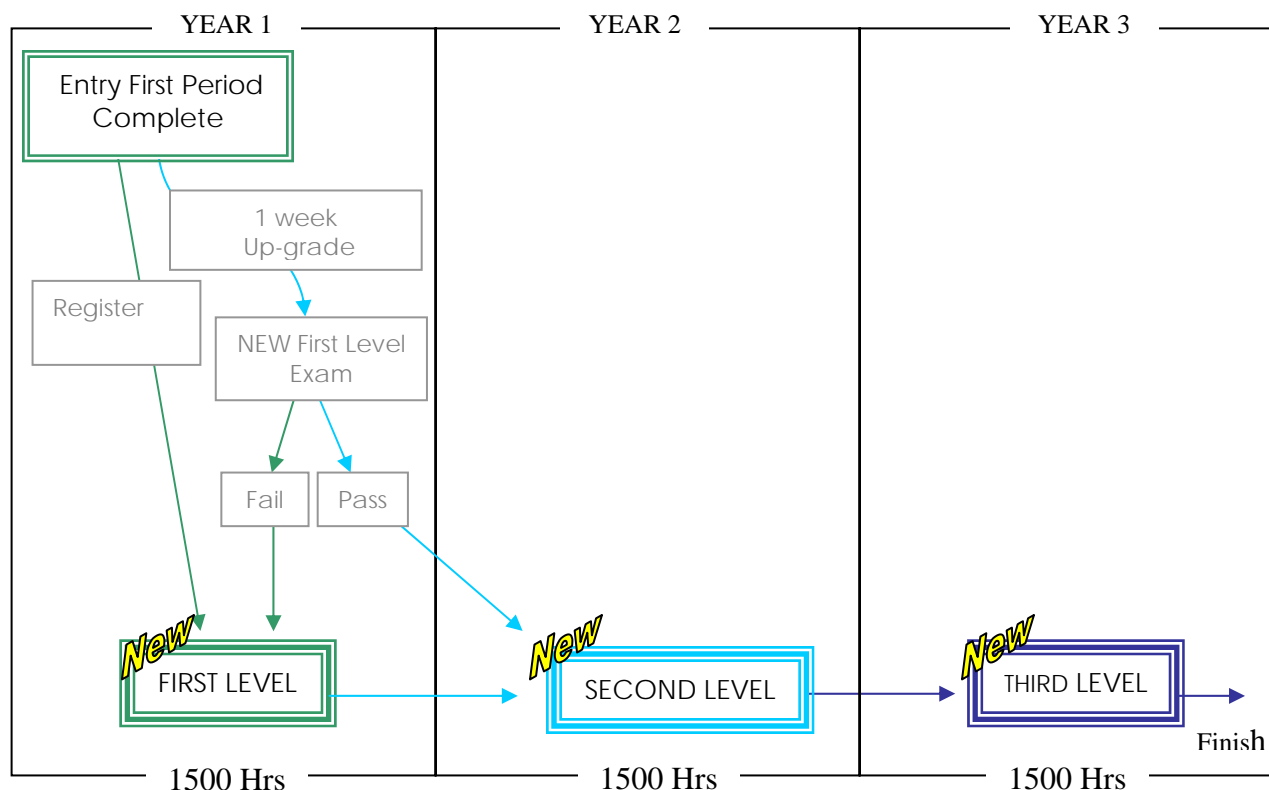




Boilermaker Apprenticeship Transition – Apprentices who have received Entry First Period credit



Impact on your Apprenticeship

Having completed and been granted credit for your Entry First period of technical training, you have the following options:

1. Register and attend the NEW First Level technical training. A portion of the material will be similar to the previous Entry First period, but there are additions.
2. Attend a 1 week up-grade that will take place July 6-13, 2009 at NAIT Souch Campus. Only at the end of the up-grade will you have an opportunity to take the NEW First Level exam.
 - Cost of the up-grade is being funded by the Boilermaker Apprenticeship Agency and Alberta Apprenticeship has waived the cost of the provincial exam
 - Upon successful completion you will be eligible for 2nd year rate and can register for the NEW Second Level technical training in the 2009/2010 term.
 - Be sure to start reviewing your Entry First period material, the NEW First Level exam will cover **ALL** material contained in the NEW 8-week program. You will be directed to the NEW First Level technical training if you are unsuccessful in the challenge exam.
